Keeping your family and our team members safe is of the utmost importance to us here at E.L.F. We have all been navigating through this new reality and doing our best to keep those in our immediate circle healthy. Here are a few things we are doing at E.L.F. to ensure that our children and staff stays safe and healthy.

Minimizing Drop Off and Pick-Up Traffic

As a proactive step, E.L.F is requiring drop off and pick-ups at the door only. Parents are not allowed in the building at this time, but instead are greeted at the door while children's temperatures are taken. By doing so, we will continue to avoid any exposure and maintain a healthy environment within our immediate community.

Masks

E.L.F is asking for all visitors and guardians to wear a facial mask while entering the childcare facility. Staff are required to wear a facial mask while on E.L.F'S premises and within six feet of others. It is left to the discretion of each family if they would like their child to wear a facial mask while attending school, however the Pre-K group ages 4-5 years old shall wear a facial covering.

School Cleanliness

E.L.F's facilities are kept clean and sanitized daily to help control germs and bacteria. A professional cleaning company every week to switch out all the rugs and sanitize our cleaning products that we use.



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Daily Health Checks

Each morning families and staff are required to complete a daily health check. Temperatures are taken at the door for each student prior to entering the building. For staff members, this includes self-temperature readings and health checks that are individually reported to the Director prior to coming to work each day. For both families and staff, we ask that you stay home if you are feeling unwell.

Attendance and Communication

Thanks to our childcare management software, Brightwheel, our signing in and out process is quick and easy. Currently, the staff are able to check in and out all children through the app. Daily communications, blogs and pictures are sent to each family daily. Parents are also able to communicate to the staff as well immediately for any questions, comments, or concerns.

Hand Hygiene

We know that one of the best and most basic ways to keep ourselves and those around us healthy is to practice good hand hygiene. E.L.F. provides easy access to hand sanitizer located at the entrance of the building. Each child is required to wash hands upon drop off before entering each classroom. All staff members that enter the building are required to wash hands as well before moving around in the center. We also routinely conduct hand washing throughout the day before eating, serving food, after using the restroom or if someone coughs or sneezes.
